



# Jr. Agility Team Canada 2016 EOJ Application

Agility Team Canada (ATC) will select teams of dogs and handlers to represent Canada at the FCI European Open Junior (EOJ) held in Cilistov, Slovakia, July 7-10, 2016

Any Junior Handler interested in competing at the 2016 European Open Junior event must submit the application below by email by Friday, April 1, 2016 to [Tiffany Salmon](#).

## **Basic Eligibility for all Candidates Applying for EOJ**

### **Junior Handlers**

- ✳ Children Category: Must be born in 2002 or later
- ✳ Junior Category: Must be born in 1998 or later
- ✳ Must be a Canadian Resident
- ✳ Must have a current Canadian passport
- ✳ Must at all times demonstrate extremely good sportsmanship while participating or watching an agility event.

### **Guardians**

- ✳ All Junior Handlers must be accompanied by a parent or responsible adult of at least 21.
- ✳ Must have a current passport
- ✳ Must at all times demonstrate good sportsmanship while watching an agility event.

### **Dogs**

- ✳ Must be at least 18 months old
- ✳ Must have achieved titles in at least Advanced or Intermediate level of competition
- ✳ Must have a current rabies vaccination
- ✳ Must be microchipped with an ISO approved chip (microchip needs to be inserted before the vaccination)
- ✳ The microchip number must be included on the rabies certificate
- ✳ Purebred and mix-breed dogs are eligible
- ✳ Team members must provide proof that their dog has been vaccinated against rabies no more than one year prior, but no less than one month prior to the date of the competition (Note: Canada Food Inspection Agency may sign-off on health certificates based on a dog having a three year vaccine but that will need to be confirmed for the designated country and CFIA).

### **Costs**

- ✳ This is a 100% self funded trip.
- ✳ Handlers are responsible for all expenses.
- ✳ Fundraising will be possible to help defray some costs.



## **Event Information all Candidates Applying for EOJ**

### **FCI Height Divisions**

- 🍁 Small (13 ¾" and under) jump 12-14"
- 🍁 Medium (16 5/8") jump 16-18"
- 🍁 Large (over 16 5/8") jump 24-26"
- 🍁 There are no Specials or Veteran options

### **Individual Event**

- 🍁 Competitors are separated by handler's age into "Children" and "Junior" categories.
- 🍁 Dogs are separated into three height categories: Small, Medium and Large
- 🍁 One Jumping course and one Standard Agility course will be run each day
- 🍁 Children & Juniors run different courses.

### **Team Event**

- 🍁 Teams are made up of 3 or 4 dogs
- 🍁 Teams are combined with Children and Junior
- 🍁 Teams are separated into Large and Small/Medium
- 🍁 If a country isn't able to field a full team, they will be combined with another country's handlers

## **Application Process**

- 🍁 Fill in the Official Dog Height Certification Form on page 3 (Small and Medium dogs only)
- 🍁 Fill in the application forms on pages 4 & 5.
- 🍁 Please email all completed forms to Team Leader, Tiffany Salmon (TNTJustChill@gmail.com), by April 1, 2016
- 🍁 Team Canada is allowed to field a team of 24 dogs with no more than 12 dogs in the Large category. For 2016, the spots will be allocated on a first come, first serve basis.



## Height Divisions

- 🍁 All Small and Medium dogs without an official FCI Measurement need to be measured by an AAC, UKI or CKC judge

Small - 12"	for dogs measuring <b>less than</b> 35 cm at the withers
Medium - 16"	for dogs measuring 35 cm or more and <b>less than</b> 43 cm at the withers
Large - 24"	for dogs measuring over 43 cm at the withers

**FOR EOJ APPLICANTS:**

**By making this application handlers accept the following (please read carefully)**

- ✳ Team members and Guardians must satisfy all conditions pertaining to travel documentation (i.e. passports and health certifications) required for themselves and their dog for travel to the event as set forth by Team Captain/Coach.
- ✳ Upon acceptance to the EOJ team, a deposit of \$300 will be required by April 15, 2016.
- ✳ Team members will actively participate in fundraising efforts and will either raise the minimum goal or supplement the amount from their own funds that are not covered by sponsorship, fundraising and donations.
- ✳ Team members must make every effort to prepare themselves and their dog for the FCI Agility World Championships and participate in any team development exercises (physical, mental, technical and tactical exercises).
- ✳ Team Members must give the CKC ATC World Team permission to use video clips of the applicant and their dog for promotional reasons.
- ✳ Team Members and Guardians must demonstrate extreme Good Sportsmanship while participating in or watching any agility event. The World Team Coach & Captain may refuse application to CKC ATC to any handler who demonstrates verbal or physical abuse to a dog or fellow competitor or acts abusive or challenging to an agility judge.
- ✳ Team members are representatives of the CKC ATC World Team and are also representing those companies that sponsor the World Team, and must behave accordingly.
