

FCI American Agility Open 2019 CKC Agility Team Canada Application

CKC Agility Team Canada (ATC) will select teams of dogs and handlers to represent Canada at the FCI Agility American Agility Open (AAO) held April 10-14, 2019 in the city of Itu-Sao Paulo-Brazil.

HOW TO APPLY TO AAO Brazil 2019 TEAM CANADA

To apply for a spot on Canada's AAO Open team, follow Steps 1-2-3 outlined below:

STEP 1.

Send in your INTENT TO APPLY to Team Captain Debby DaCosta by email to debby.tpf@gmail.com ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 25, 2019 with these details:

- Handler's name, and CKC Membership number
- Dog's call name, Registered name if one, CKC Registration number, Breed/Mix, Male/Female, Altered/Intact, Age, Date of Birth
- Microchip number
- FCI jump height (Small, Medium, or Large)
- Dog's most advanced agility title and in what organization
 NOTE: Dogs must meet the Basic Agility Requirement of the FCI Level 2 title, or
 the equivalent in Canada. CKC ATC asks for an Intermediate title in CKC or AKC or
 an Advanced title in AAC/USDAA or a Novice title in UKI.
- Previous flight experience is strongly advised.

STEP 2.

Send in your AAO 2019 TEAM APPLICATION to Team Captain Debby DaCosta by email to debby.tpf@gmail.com ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 29, 2019.

STEP 3.

Complete the measurement form IF NEEDED scan, and email to debby.tpf@gmail.com
** THIS IS ONLY REQUIRED FOR SMALL AND MEDIUM DOGS that have not previously been CKC ATC World Team members, or measured for an FCI event.

Basic Eligibility for Applying to CKC AGILITY TEAM CANADA

- Candidates must be Canadian citizens or residents of Canada for past 24 months.
- Dogs must be identified with an ISO microchip and the rabies certificate must include the microchip numbers.
- Dogs in Small and Medium divisions must be measured by an Agility Judge using an accurate measuring device, and submit a height form signed by the Judge.
- · Candidates must be willing to travel to Brazil at their own expense.
- Candidates must be willing to acquire any documentation for themselves and their dog required for travel/entry into the designated South American country.
- Team members must provide proof that their dog has been vaccinated against rabies no more than one year prior, but no less than one month prior to the date of the competition (Note: Canada Food Inspection Agency may sign-off on health certificates based on a dog having a three year vaccine however, each individual country may require a more current vaccine. It is your responsibility to confirm with the designated country and CFIA.)
- Candidates under 18 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian, and at their own expense.
- Candidates must at all times demonstrate extremely good sportsmanship while participating or watching an agility event.

Height Divisions

Small - for dogs measuring less than 35 cm at the withers

Medium - for dogs 35 cm or more, and less than 43 cm, at withers

Large - for dogs measuring over 43 cm at the withers

FCI American Agility Open 2019

The FCI American Agility Open 2019 Event is an 'Open' event, without breed restrictions on entry. Eligibility is as follows:

- Open to all dogs, pedigree and mixed.
- All teams must meet the Basic Eligibility Requirements.
- There is a NO LIMIT to the number of dogs each country can enter in the AAO Individual Competition.
- There is NO LIMIT to the number of dogs each country can enter in the AAO Team Competition.

FCI American Agility Open Brazil 2019

AWARDS (Small/Med/Lg) are given for 1st, 2nd, 3rd for each round, and for FINALS.

The **AAO INDIVIDUAL COMPETITION** comprises the following for each of Small, Medium and Large:

- 2 Qualifying Jumping rounds
- 2 Qualifying Agility rounds
- 1 Agility Repechage (last chance) round
- 1 FINAL INDIVIDUAL round

The AAO TEAM COMPETITION consists of:

- 1 Qualifying Jumping Team round
- 1 Qualifying Agility Team round
- 1 FINAL AGILITY round

TEAM SCORING: The best 3 of 4 scores in each team are used. The Best Handler/Dog Team in each country that does not have a qualifying team will run in Finals.

MIXED Teams will be formed when a country does not have enough competitors to form a full team. Mixed Teams will be eligible to qualify for the FINAL. Mixed Teams will be formed after the completion of registration for traditional teams.

** To reach FINALS, the team must have one round with at least 2 NOT ELIMINATED pairs.

FINALS will be scored in a traditional way, sum of times plus faults scores for the best three pairs of the team.

CKC Agility Team Canada Code of Conduct

- Team members must satisfy all conditions pertaining to travel documentation (i.e. passports and visas and health certifications) required for themselves and their dog for travel to the event as set forth by Team Leader/Captain/Coach as more information becomes available regarding travel requirements.
- Team members must be team supporters and exhibit team sportsmanship both at the event and prior to the event.
- Team members must make every effort to prepare themselves and their dog for the FCI American Agility Open and participate in team activities as provided by the Team Leader/Captain/Coach.
- Team Members must give the CKC ATC permission to use video clips/ photographs of the applicant and their dog for promotional reasons.
- Team Members must at all times demonstrate extreme Good Sportsmanship while participating in or watching any agility event. The Team Leader may refuse application to CKC ATC to any handler who demonstrates verbal or physical abuse to a dog or fellow competitor or acts abusive or challenging to an agility judge.
- Team members are representatives of the CKC Agility Team Canada and are also representing those companies that sponsor the Team, and are asked to behave accordingly.
